### Background

1. Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) Officers have been working with County Councillors Champken-Woods and Gregory and a few Nelson Street residents on proposals to:
  - make Nelson Street one-way south to north,
  - change the priorities at the Nelson Street / Southern Road / Elms Road junction,
  - introduce speed cushion traffic calming on Nelson Street to curtail the speed of the one-way traffic.
2. See Appendix A for the consultation plan.
3. The next stage of the process is for Thame Town Council to endorse / promote the scheme, and should this be agreed, OCC will carry out an informal consultation with the Nelson Street residents (including the fire station & theatre) and the wider town.
