OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (THAME AND VARIOUS PARISHES) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20**

The Oxfordshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82, 83 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Thame and Various Parishes) (Speed Limits) Order 202* and shall come into force on the day of 202*, and variously includes parts of the Parishes of Great Haseley, Great Milton, Moreton, Postcombe, Thame, Tiddington with Albury and Tetsworth, and Towersey.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
- 5. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.
- 6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 7. The Oxfordshire County Council (Thame and Various Parishes) (Speed Limits) Order 2023 is hereby revoked.
