Title: Thame Museum – Roof Repairs

Action Required

1. To approve works, as identified in the Building Condition Survey, to Thame Museum roof.

Background

- 2. A Building Condition Survey carried out on 15 January 2024 was presented to the Policy & Resources Committed on 27 February 2024. Within the report immediate action was identified related to work to the roof to stop water ingress.
- A Scope of Works & Clarifications (Appendix A) together with an extract from the 5-year PMP Report (Appendix B) for work to the roof were drawn up in conjunction with a volunteer from Thame Museum with a career background in project management within the construction industry.
- 4. Nine roofing companies were approached and invited to submit a quotation for the work as identified in the documents above. Two companies visited the museum and submitted quotations; a third company replied to say that due to work schedules they would not be able to submit a quotation.
