- To ratify 'completion' of actions within the GLP – agreeing that enough action has been taken to consider the action completed.

Deliverables

- To lead on projects, activities and events that will enable the achievement of the GLP.
- To research best practice elsewhere at the start of projects that are new to Thame and share this learning back to the Working Group to influence action.
- To attend partnership meetings with relevant groups to promote the GLP and share progress towards completion as required,
- To identify and support applications to other funding sources to allow the actions of the GLP to be achieved more quickly.
- To proactively engage with members of the community to better inform people about work taking place in Thame that overlaps with the GLP actions and support collaboration with these groups to avoid duplication of effort.
- To attend the Environmental Forum as a representative of Thame Town Council.

Scope / Jurisdiction

The Group is required to:

- Only work on projects identified within the Thame Green Living Plan 2020-2030.
- Work with stakeholders such as local groups, other parishes, and local authorities as necessary.
- Provide an update report to each meeting of the Environment & Assets Committee
