- Is continued provision for Longcot (which necessitates a lengthy detour) worthwhile given that fewer than one passenger per day on average uses the service?

- There is no evidence of persistent reliability issues with the current timetable.
 However, officers will consult with the operator prior to re-tendering the contract in case minor modifications will be helpful.
- The cost per passenger journey is high, but not unexpected given the service had only been in operation for 7 months.
- Occasional capacity issues have been reported with the 108 service. As a result, it is
 intended that two versions of the specification will be made available for tender to
 explore the possibility of operation with a slightly larger vehicle (around 25 seats).
 However, it is not intended that the bus will replace existing provision to schools in
 Headington and Oxford.
- It has been suggested that the service could potentially revert to its former route in Stanton St John, operating via the B4027 instead of Middle Road and Cox Lane.
 Officers are keen to hear from Stanton St John Parish Council on this issue.
- Usage from Blackthorn and Piddington is disappointing (fewer than one passenger per day on average).

- Officers intend to re-tender service 320 broadly on the current basis and hope that with patronage now a known quantity tender prices (and therefore the cost per passenger journey) will reduce to a degree.
- The cost per passenger journey is very high and disappointing given that the service (in some form) has been in operation for a significant period of time. A considerable improvement in usage is required to maintain this service in the long term.
