- 2. Since the last Planning Committee, a consultation has been delivered by OCC using a Map and Pin exercise that has allowed members of the public to identify the safety concerns, improvements needed and other comments about waking and cycling around Thame.
- 3. Members of the LCWIP-WG were involved in contributing, as well as encouraging others to contribute to the process. The Environmental Project Officer also met with different residents who have disabilities, or support those who are not able bodied by regularly pushing a wheelchair around the town centre. Their feedback was captured and entered onto the consultation.
